

DONNER SENIOR TEAM EXPECTATIONS and COMMITMENT

After speaking with the Donner Coaching Staff, we arrived at the following conclusion concerning the SENIOR program at DONNER swim club. THE FOLLOWING WILL BE THE PART OF THE PROGRAM WHERE COMMITMENT IS TRULY THAT, COMMITMENT.

The SENIOR team is in transition. Senior members must be ready to come to the workouts. We understand kids playing other sports, however the age-group and below team levels will be structured for those that need to miss practices. Members of the Senior team prior to the 2010 short course season, that participate in other sports, will remain on the Senior Team. The SENIOR team needs to become a TRUE SENIOR TEAM once again. A team where kids attend all the state and sectionals meets, and above, during both winter and summer seasons.

We will have two senior groups beginning next week, the blue group and the white group. When at full status the blue group will have 9-10 practices a week. You must attend all practices except for ACADEMIC ISSUES COMMUNICATED TO THE COACHING STAFF. The white group will have 7-8 practices per week and you attend 90% of those workouts

To be on the senior team you must be ready to attend all of the required workouts and commit. Otherwise, you remain with the age-group team until such a time. YOU ALSO MUST BE IN THE 8TH GRADE, AND PREFERABLY MOVE UP THE SUMMER BEFORE YOU GO TO HIGH SCHOOL.

The decision to move to the senior group needs to be a family decision AND COMMITMENT.
